By January 2023, 50% of WV K-4 students will demonstrate mastery of assessed essential standards, as evidenced by the essential standard spreadsheets.

By May 2023, 80% of WV K-4 students will pass at least one iReady lesson per week. Continue implementing collaborative recognition program for iReady lessons passed by classroom or grade level.

By the end of the 2022-2023 school year the percentage of students who demonstrate at or above grade level on either letters/sounds or STAR assessment will increase by the cohort data below:

Kindergarten: 0% to 85%

First: Baseline data will be collected in January

Second: 29% to 50% Third: 33% to 53% Fourth: 12% to 32%
