Eastview Mathematics Goal

By the end of the 2019-2020 school year, Eastview Elementary will increase the percent of students in the Tier 1(on grade level or beyond) Ready Math category by 5%.

2018-2019 End-of-the-Year Results: 37%

2019-2020 End-of-the-Year Results: 42%

Tier 1 students will increase from 3% (fall 2019) to 15% (winter 2019) using end-of-the-year view on placement assessment

Tier 1 students will increase from 15% (winter 2019) to 42% (spring 2020) using end-of-the-year view on placement assessment.

80% of students will reach the prescribed 45 minutes per week of individualized interventions as evidenced by a monthly building report

Eastview English Language Arts Goals

By the end of the 2019-2020 school year, students in the third and fourth grade will increase their total percent of students who meet or exceed on the IAR test by 5%. (Third Grade: 27.5% > 32%; Fourth Grade: 33.9% > 39%)

By January 2020, 50% of our K-4 students will increase their baseline writing score to 35% on the grade level rubric for the winter writing assessment.

By May 2020, 75% of our K-4 students will increase their winter writing score to 70% on the grade level rubric for the spring writing assessment.

By January 2020, 65% of K-4 students will achieve Tier 1 status on the AimsWeb+ composite score.

By May 2020, 75% of K-4 students will achieve Tier 1 status on the AimsWeb+ composite score.

By November 26th, develop grade level rubrics that define the 4 components of writing for each grade level

Administer and grade writing prompts three times per year Oct. 1st, January 16th, April 17th
